The deadline for BET NETWORKS and GENSLER applications ONLY is March 28, 2008. For legal reasons, you must be 18 by June 1, 2008, to apply. For the BET Networks and Gensler New York internships, you must also have completed two years of college by summer 2008. If you are selected, proof of age will be required. Finalists will be interviewed via telephone by CosmoGIRL! and participating companies. Interns will be paid either \$8 per hour, or in the case of Gensler New York, the usual company wage. See rules at right for details. Due to the large number of submissions, we can only contact you if you are selected.

THE COSMOGIRL! PROJECT 2024 INTERNSHIP SUMMER 2008. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER.

To enter, fill out the application at left or download it at cosmogirl.com/2024. Select the internship you're applying for: BET Networks or Gensler New York ("Company"). Internships are subject to change. Send application to CosmoGIRL! Project 2024 Internships 2008, 300 West 57th Street, 20th Floor, New York, NY 10019. One intern will be selected for each 8-week internship that will run approximately June 2, 2008–July 27, 2008, depending on housing availability. Each intern will be paid \$8 per hour for a 35-hour workweek. Travel to and from New York City at the start and end of the internship, room and 10 meals a week (to be arranged by CosmoGIRL!), and travel to and from workplace will be paid for and arranged by CosmoGIRL! at its sole discretion (approximate value: \$6,000). Other expenses are the responsibility of the intern. Applications (including essays and reference letters) will be judged by a qualified panel of CosmoGIRL! editors, whose decisions on all matters are final, based on originality, creativity, and clarity of expression in the written essay, as well as phone interviews with both CosmoGIRL! and the Company where the intern will work. The minimum cumulative GPA required is 3.0 (85 if your school grades on a scale of 1–100). Interns will be notified by phone on or around April 15, 2008. If the prospective intern is unreachable within five days, the internship may be forfeited and awarded to an alternate applicant. Internships are open to girls 18 and over (as of June 1, 2008; for the Gensler New York and BET Networks internships, you must have also completed two years of college by summer 2008) who are residents of the 50 United States, Canada, or the District of Columbia, and have the legal right to work in the U.S. (Residents of Puerto Rico are not eligible.) Void where prohibited. Interns will be asked to submit an affidavit of eligibility/release and proof of age. Interns must provide proof of medical insurance valid in New York City throughout the internship. Applications must be postmarked by March 28, 2008. Interns must sign an agreement of CosmoGIRL!'s expectations after the selection process, which will include details on dress code, conduct, repercussions for unmet expectations, etc. Applications become the property of CosmoGIRL! and Company of requested internship and will not be returned. CosmoGIRL! and its agents cannot acknowledge any entries. Interns are responsible for taxes on their income. Interns are temporary employees and will not be eligible for any of the Company's or CosmoGIRL!'s benefit plans. Applicants represent that their applications are original, have not been published previously, and do not violate the rights of any third party. For a list of selected interns, send a stamped, self-addressed envelope to Project 2024 Internship 2008, 300 West 57th Street, 20th Floor, New York, NY 10019, after July 1, 2008.
